BMW Charity Rides Again...





A group of 60 motorcyclists took to the open road from September 28th to October 1st for the 16th annual BMW Charity Ride, led by the original California Highway Patrol cruiser of Broderick Crawford from the 1950's TV series Highway Patrol. The four-day tour covered 1,200 miles of California's most scenic roads, raising funds for the St. Francis Medical Center Foundation in Lynwood, CA and the California Highway Patrol 11-99 Foundation.

The event has a loyal following of BMW dealers, corporate executives, attorneys, doctors and entertainment moguls from all over the U.S. who ride together each year to raise money for the foundations by making a significant donation to participate. BMW Motorrad USA, the ride's principal sponsor, provides motorcycles and support for the event. This year's ride was devoted to the memory of the 7 CHP Officers who made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty during the past 12 months.
